### PAYMENT POLICY

Payments are due the Friday prior to your child attending camp. Payments not received on Mondays will be assessed a late fee by our Billing Department. All fees will be deducted automatically by a debit/credit card or checking/savings account. The Y believes that no youth should be turned away due to the inability to pay. Financial assistance is available upon request. W2 state and county funding also accepted. Consider purchasing a youth membership to qualify for the discounted rate. If you need to make special payment arrangements; please call 920.954.7646.

### SCHEDULE CHANGES

Removal/switching of days will be accepted through Monday, April 3 at no charge. Contracted days after April 3 will be charged out in full unless a termination notification is given per policy. Adding of days will be accepted based on availability. All requests must be submitted in writing by email. For **Y/Shioc/sites** at **schoolage@ymcafoxcities.org**. For **CLC** at **kuslabar@ymcafoxcities.org**. If staff are able to make a location switch on the day of attendance due to unforeseen circumstance, billing will charge out a \$5 change fee, which will be billed the following week.

### TERMINATION POLICY

Terminations for the full or remainder of contracted days require a two-week written notification in writing by email. For **Y/Shioc/sites** at **schoolage@ymcafoxcities.org**. For **CLC** at **kuslabar@ymcafoxcities.org**. Terminations prior to April 3 are no charge. If a termination is received after the deadline, the 2-week stated payment policy is still in effect, full rates apply.

### MEALS/SNACKS

School Age participants at the Appleton YMCA and school site locations must provide a daily lunch; program will provide AM/PM snacks. CLC offers AM/PM snacks and a pre-pay lunch option for \$2.50. Camp Shioc participants must provide a daily lunch and both AM/PM snacks. 1% milk will be provided for lunch at all site locations.

### FIELDTRIPS

Children attending a fieldtrip are required to wear a color coordinated t-shirt for safety purposes. New teal fieldtrip t-shirts for Y/Shioc/school sites, CLC are green and can be reused from last year or available for purchase when you register for \$10. **Please note:** Staff do not stay back on fieldtrip days due to summer school participation.
