# 2017 School Age Summer Program

The School Age Summer Program is an exciting and fun-filled licensed program for children ages 5-12 years old. Program participants will learn the Y's core values of Caring, Honesty, Respect and Responsibility through various activities including fieldtrips, arts & crafts, science experiments, teambuilding and exploring the outdoors!

## REGISTRATION

A \$25 non-refundable registration fee per child is required. There is a minimum of 2 contracted days per week per child required.

Open registration will begin Monday, January 2 at 6:00 AM. Please find the registration steps in this brochure.

## PAYMENT POLICY

Payments will be automatically deducted from a checking/savings account or credit card. At the Y, we believe that no youth should be turned away due to the inability to pay. Financial assistance is available upon request. Also consider purchasing a Youth Membership for \$15 a month to qualify for the discounted rate.

## CANCELLATION POLICY

Schedule changes such as canceling, adding or switching days will be accepted until **April 3, 2017**, with no charge. After this date, you are responsible for payment of all contracted days. Summer cancellation requires a two-week signed and dated written notice, which needs to be given to Amber Radtke. Payment is in effect for the two-weeks whether your child attends or not.

## FEES

Program fees include AM and PM snack and all fieldtrip expenses. Half Day rates are only allowed during the weeks of Summer School.

**SITES:** The Fox West YMCA will offer our summer programs at the Fox West YMCA and Greenville Elementary.

**AGES:** 5-12 Years

**PARENT ORIENTATION:** Orientation for parent information regarding the School Age Summer Program will be held at the Fox West YMCA, Thursday, May 18, 2017 at 6:30 PM.

## **AVAILABILITY**

Fox West YMCA and Greenville Elementary locations are available full days only, Monday–Friday.

Hours of operation are 6:30 AM–6:00 PM. Half day options are only available to children who are enrolled in Summer School. Please refer to half-day rates. Proof of Summer School enrollment must be given to Amber Radtke before Summer Care starts.

## **WHAT TO BRING TO SCHOOL AGE SUMMER PROGRAM**

Everyday your child will need to have a water bottle, sunscreen and bug repellent that is clearly labeled with their name. We will store sunscreen and bug repellent at our sites. If it is a fieldtrip day, please check the fieldtrip information sheet for other necessary information. No hand held video games, IPOD's/MP3 players, cell phones or toys. Children are to wear tennis shoes or enclosed sandals (no flip-flops).

## **LUNCH**

Please send your child with a nutritious cold lunch every day. Due to severe allergies in our program, we have chosen to be a peanut free zone.

## **SPECIAL SCHEDULED ACTIVITIES:**

**Monday • Club day:** Clubs will be meet from 1:00–2:00 PM and will run for 3–weeks.

Children/teachers will then choose 3 different clubs for the next 3–weeks to participate in. All children will participate in clubs. (Clubs include choices such as Legos, sports, arts and crafts and cooking).

**Tuesday • Swim day:** Children that attend the Fox West YMCA will be swimming from 12:30–1:30. Children that attend the Greenville Elementary School site will be swimming from 1:30–2:30. Please remember your child's swimming suit and towel.

**Wednesday • Fieldtrip day:** Please see the fieldtrip form for necessary items that your child may need. Field trips are subject to be changed or cancelled.

**Thursday • STEM day:** The children will be doing various activities and projects related to STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics).

**Friday • Swim day**

## **FIELDTRIPS**

Children attending a fieldtrip are required to wear a yellow fieldtrip themed t-shirt for safety purposes along with tennis shoes. You may use your shirt from a previous year or purchase one online.

**TRANSPORTATION:** Transportation is contracted through the Hortonville Area School District.

## **TRANSFERS**

If your child is enrolled at the Fox West YMCA site, parents can sign them up for swim lesson, etc. The School Age summer teachers will transfer the child to their class only if the class/lesson is held at the Fox West YMCA location. We ask you to please fill out a 'Transfer Card'. If a class is scheduled at the same time as a fieldtrip, children are required to go on the fieldtrip and miss their class.

## New for 2017 – Online Registration

Follow the steps below to complete your online registration

### DAY CAMP

1. Login to your online account using your email address and password at **ymcafoxcities.org**.
2. Go to Program Search and choose Browse All.
3. Select Day Camp – Summer from the list of categories.
4. From the list of available programs, choose the appropriate program, location and instances that the participant would like to attend.
5. When finish selecting, choose Register.
6. Complete all registration requirements and questions and choose Check Out.
7. Select from any stored billing methods or add a credit card or bank account information and select Pay Now.
8. You will be emailed a receipt once payment has been received.
